“Showcasing Sectoral Ombudsman (Municipal, Police and Military Ombudsman)”

Tuesday, August 23, 2022 (10AM SA) GMT+2

Whilst the reach of the national Ombudsman is very wide, some countries have established sector specific Ombudsman to deal with sector specific issues. AORC's next webinar deals with sectoral Ombudsman and is entitled 'Showcasing Sectoral Ombudsman (Municipal, Police and Military Ombudsman)'.

The 'Showcasing Sectoral Ombudsman (Municipal, Police and Military Ombudsman)' webinar would discuss the legal basis and mandate of the sectoral Ombudsman, the relationship with the national Ombudsman, as well as the process for the appointment and removal of staff. Time permitting the speakers would also discuss the independence and reporting structures of sectoral Ombudsman and, provide guidance on how to establish a sectoral Ombudsman office, lessons learnt, and advice based on their respective experiences.

Webinar Goal: This Webinar is an excellent opportunity to enhance the knowledge of how the sectoral Ombudsman operates and how they are used to further protect the rights of citizens.

Webinar Method: Each Speaker will incorporate a mix of presentations and responses to questions raised before and during the Webinar.
