## **1. STRENGTHENING THE PFDC SYSTEM**



During the 2020-2022 term, we strengthened the concept of the PFDC System, thus understood as a national network for the defense of human rights composed of the union of members of the MP, who work in an articulated way to contribute to the construction of a society freer, fairer and more solidary. The performance of the PFDC System is based on dialogue and interaction with State bodies, international organizations and representatives of civil society, with the aim of guaranteeing, protecting and promoting the fundamental rights of the Brazilian population. Its central body is the PFDC, which has the Naops, the PRDCs, the WGs and the TRs.

In this line, it was very important to hand over to PFDC the attribution of reviewing promotions for the shelving of extrajudicial procedures based on the conclusion of the Conduct Adjustment Term (TAC). This return – defined by the Prosecutor General of the Republic through Ordinance n° 841/2020/PGR/MPF – allowed us to work on the dissemination, throughout the national territory, of good practices based on the performance of colleagues from MPF. We encourage, for example, the adoption of initiatives aimed at improving accessibility equipment for people with disabilities when boarding and disembarking at airports; the punishment, in the civil and administrative spheres, of agents involved in human rights violations during the period of the Military Dictatorship; the investigation of violations of the rights to life and health with regard to events such as the Soccer America Cup in the context of the Covid19 pandemic; the adoption of measures that guarantee land regularization; the minimum reservation of vacancies for black candidates and people with disabilities in Federal Institutes of Education.

Within the scope of coordination initiatives, we carried out work visits to the five Naops, which are responsible for reviewing promotions for archiving and decisions to decline allocation, in addition to settling allocation conflicts within the respective region.

Another achievement registered in this administration was the return of the PFDC to the National Human Rights Council (CNDH). In November 2021, the Federal Ombudsman was designated as the replacement for the Prosecutor General of the Republic at CNDH. The participation of PFDC in the council allows for a more effective contribution of the PFDC System in the defense of citizenship and human rights.

#### **1. STRENGTHENING THE PFDC SYSTEM**



Defining priorities and coordinating actions in matters so dear to society, such as human rights, is not an easy task, especially in a country of continental dimensions and so unequal. For planning the 2020-2022 biennium, the definition of topics to be addressed by the WGs and TRs took place based on a national online consultation with members of the PFDC System from across the country, held in June 2020 - one month after the beginning of the new management, which occurred at the beginning of the Covid-19 pandemic. The aim was to choose, in a democratic and participatory way, the social problems that most needed PFDC's attention. All contemplated themes had been worked on in previous years, directly or indirectly. Others emerged, occupying the main focus of debates and initiatives, such as the defense of the LGBTI+ population (Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender, Intersexual), women, the elderly and the population in street situation, as well as access to high cost medicines and the fight against human trafficking.

The members of the WGs and TRs have dedicated themselves, on a voluntary basis, to studying the issues in depth, with the involvement of experts and public authorities who deal with the issues. They identify and technically support requests for information from various public bodies made directly by the Federal Ombudsman - which encouraged, during the period, the identification of effective practices to be replicated through the launch of coordinated actions; the promotion of knowledge through webinars; and inter-institutional cooperation in favor of guaranteeing, defending and promoting fundamental rights. There was also monitoring of the humanitarian crisis experienced by Venezuelans, which has impacted the Brazilian population, mainly in the North Region.

During the period, an outstanding initiative in the promotion of human rights was the Citizenship Encounters Project, which brought together specialists to discuss topics relevant to Brazilian society. In two years, 30 virtual events were organized, which recorded more than 20,000 views. The inauguration of the photo gallery of the body's holders marked the celebration of PFDC's 29th anniversary, representing an act of gratitude and recognition to all the people who helped build the PFDC.

## **1.1 PERFORMANCE HIGHLIGHTS**



#### **Migration crisis**

The migratory crisis has been accompanied by the PFDC System, notably with regard to the cut of resources for the Operação Acolhida, conducted by the Brazilian Army since 2018, in the cities of Manaus (AM), Boa Vista and Pacaraima (RR). The Federal Ombudsman has been to the North Region four times, interacting with various actors responsible for the reception of Venezuelan, indigenous and non-indigenous migrants and refugees. In addition, he worked with the National Refugee Committee (Conare), of the Ministry of Justice and Public Security (MJSP), to analyze the ordinance that prevented Venezuelans from entering Brazil, in the context of the Covid-19 pandemic. In 2021, an event was held on Immigrant Day - June 25 -, addressing topics such as structural xenophobia. Together with the Auschwitz Institute for the Prevention of Genocide and Mass Atrocities, members of PFDC met to discuss the results of research that focused on the situation of young Venezuelan migrants in Boa Vista. The PFDC System also acted in the humanitarian crisis in Afghanistan, with regard to the reception of refugees.



#### **Humanized service**

In February 2021, PFDC participated in the renewal of the collaboration term for the protection of migrants who were not admitted at Guarulhos airport, in São Paulo, originally signed in 2019. The agreement created conditions for humanized service for migrants arriving in Brazil through that airport, but not admitted into the country. In 2020, 297 people had been assisted by services established from this collaboration term.

The ceremony was attended by signatories of the document, including representatives of PFDC, the National Secretariat of Justice (SNJ) of the Ministry of Justice (MJSP), the Federal Public Defender's Office (DPU), the City Hall of Guarulhos and the High Commission of Nations Nations for Refugees (UNHCR).

#### **Citizenship Encounters Project**

Since November 2020, PFDC has been promoting webinars, seeking to strengthen the citizen's rights defense network, disseminate knowledge and foster citizenship. In May 2022, the Citizenship Encounters Project reached the mark of 31 virtual events organized. The core of the project is to promote debates with human rights experts, jurists and academics. Several topics have already been discussed: protection of human rights at all links in the production chain, socio-environmental accountability, transitional justice, large enterprises, mining, uberization of the economy, international treaties and the global agenda, violence against women, adequate nutrition, among others. Available on the PFDC YouTube Channel, the contents of the webinars have been converted into podcasts, to be heard on audio platforms. The first season dealt with Human Rights and Business.

#### **Combating homotransphobia**

PFDC joined the "Eu Sou Respeito" campaign, created by the PRDC in Rio Grande do Sul. Commemorative dates have been used to promote awareness among citizens about respect for the LGBTI+ population. Within the scope of the Citizenship Encounters Project, a webinar was held on the fight against homotransphobia, based on decisions of the Federal Supreme Court (STF) so that homophobic and transphobic behaviors are framed in the typification of the Racism Law, until there is a specific law on the subject. Representatives of the Justice System discussed STF decisions in the Direct Action of Unconstitutionality by Omission (ADO) n° 26 and in the Writ of Injunction (MI) n° 4,733, aiming to understand them and propose solutions to overcome the challenges that separate them from practical application. Together with representatives of the LGBTI+ National Alliance and the Center for Human Rights, PFDC discussed actions for the dissemination of rights already achieved by the LGBTI+ population, such as the adoption of children by same-sex couples, marriage of homosexual people, blood donation and criminalization of homotransphobia. The so-called Fulfillment Project, proposed by these entities, aims to promote and disseminate the content of Supreme Court decisions concerning citizenship and human rights of the Brazilian LGBTQIA+ population.



#### **PERFORMANCE HIGHLIGHTS**

#### **Combating Racism**

Police lethality is one of the topics covered by the PFDC Racial Discrimination Combat and Promotion of Racial Equality WG. In addition to promoting a public hearing that discussed proposals for changes related to the fight against structural racism, the PFDC System has followed the Claim of Non-compliance with Fundamental Precept (ADPF) n° 635, which deals with the carrying out of police operations in communities in Rio de Janeiro during the pandemic. In a public hearing promoted by STF, PFDC presented contributions related to the rigorous training of police officers in human rights, starting with the leaders, and the execution of activities within the strict limits imposed by the principle of proportionality. PFDC also participated in discussions on a permanent agenda of actions aimed at confronting structural racism in commercial establishments. One of them addressed the realization of professional training programs aimed exclusively at black and brown people, by the company Magazine Luiza. Another document dealt with the death of João Alberto Silveira Freitas, on the eve of Black Consciousness Day, in 2020, beaten to death on the premises of the Carrefour supermarket, in Porto Alegre (RS).



In a joint effort with the Woman, Child, Adolescent and the Elderly: Protection of Rights WG, Public Note No. 4/2021 highlighted the National Day of Tereza de Benguela and Black Women, established by Law No. 12,987/2014, and celebrated annually on July 25th, inspired by the International Day of AfroLatin-Caribbean Women. It highlighted the struggle of black women against gender oppression, exploitation and racism, especially in the field of representative democracy. It stressed the urgency of building a public policy suited for the new times.

In January of this year, Brazil finally promulgated the Inter-American Convention against Racism, Racial Discrimination and Related Intolerance. The approval took place after the issuance of Public Note No. 6/2021, prepared by the PFDC, in November 2021, which defended the conclusion of the process of internalization of the convention, signed by Brazil in 2013. Ratified in May 2021, the rule needed to be enacted by presidential decree to have full legal effect. The convention is considered by the MPF to be an important instrument to combat religious intolerance, with a view to dealing with the matter and defining it for legal purposes.

#### **PERFORMANCE HIGHLIGHTS**



#### Institutional dialogues

The Federal Ombudsman visited the five Naops in order to intensify dialogue with their members. On the agenda, organizational strengthening and the construction of an agenda of initiatives aimed at increasing and defending human rights. At the meetings, Vilhena highlighted the change made through Ordinance No. 841/2020/PGR/MPF, which returned the review of filing promotions based on the conclusion of TACs to the Ombudsman. He explained that the intention was to allow the dissemination of good practices by members of all states, as in the case of the TAC that brought improvements related to the accessibility of people with disabilities when boarding and disembarking at airports, which initiated a coordinated action of PFDC. He also highlighted the investments made in improving management information based on the development of business intelligence (BI) tools to improve decision-making.

#### Defense of the democratic order

The Federal Ombudsman signed a memorandum of understanding, in December 2021, with the National Council for Human Rights (CNDH), the National Defender of Human Rights (DNDH) and the Commission on Human Rights and Minorities of the Chamber of Deputies (CDHM-CD). The group has been meeting to discuss actions and initiatives that can be carried out together to guarantee clean, safe, fair and democratic elections. A result of this work is the cooperation agreement with the Superior Electoral Court (TSE). The purpose of the partnership is to define measures and projects that can be carried out jointly to face disinformation in the electoral process and to strengthen confidence in electoral institutions.

## **1.2 COORDINATED ACTIONS**



#### Architectural accessibility

Two coordinated actions on the subject. The first encourages the celebration of TACs with public service concessionaires, in order to guarantee better accessibility conditions for people with disabilities when boarding and arriving at airports. The second exhorts PRDCs to carry out an initiative in the same direction with public and private higher education institutions, aiming at the implementation of legal accessibility requirements, as well as the payment of compensation for collective moral damages, with explicit rules regarding the allocation of resources.

## Assessment of damages to fundamental rights



Suggestion to the PRDCs of the states of Goiás, Mato Grosso, Rio de Janeiro and São Paulo to investigate possible practices that violate, especially, the rights to life and health, caused by people and legal organizers, broadcasters and sponsors of the Copa America Male Soccer 2021.

## Reservation of vacancies for black and disabled candidates



Aims to ensure the effectiveness of the reservation of vacancies in public tenders for black candidates and candidates with disabilities, under the terms of the legislation in force and the jurisprudence of STF regarding the matter.

## Land regularization programs (Titula Brasil)



Encourages the adoption of measures that guarantee compliance with the principles of public administration, recognition of traditional territories and respect for the constitutional allocation of federal public lands.

## Inapplicability of the Amnesty Law



Seeks to identify and punish, in the civil and administrative spheres, agents involved in human rights violations during the dictatorship period (1964-1985). The initiative aims to comply with the effects of the decision issued by the Superior Court of Justice (STJ) in Special Appeal 1836862/SP, which deals with the inapplicability of the Amnesty Law (Law 6683/1979) to these types of actions.

#### **COORDINATED ACTIONS**

#### Implementation of bodies to prevent and combat torture

Encourages PRDCs in 21 states and the Federal District (DF), with the engagement of other public bodies and institutions, to celebrate TACs for the implementation of local committees and mechanisms to prevent and combat torture (Law No. 12,847/2013). The coordinated action seeks to honor the commitment assumed in article 3 of the Optional Protocol to the United Nations Convention against Torture and other Cruel, Inhuman or Degrading Treatment.

In February 2022, during a meeting with members of the National Council of Attorneys General (CNPG), Carlos Alberto Vilhena, the Federal Ombudsman, highlighted the importance of the joint work of the Brazilian MP to strengthen the National System for the Prevention and Combat of Torture (SNPCT).



## **2. PFDC ACTION INSTRUMENTS**

Among the instruments used by the Federal Ombudsman are the issuing of official letters, recommendations, representations, technical notes and public notes. Below are some decisions signed during the period 2020-2022. The full documents can be found on the website www.mpf.mp.br/pfdc, as well as other initiatives promoted during the period.

**Decision n° 377/2020/PFDC/CAV** - alludes to the representation about homophobic and transphobic speeches given by the President of the Republic, Jair Messias Bolsonaro, on an official visit to the state of Maranhão and live broadcast on social networks.

**Decision n° 383/2020/PFDC/CAV** - deals with representation requesting actions regarding specialized and criminal material, apology for torture, incitement to hatred and misogyny, which circulates on social networks in the country, presented by instructors from Alfacon, preparatory school for aspiring military and federal police officers.

**Decision nº 103/2021/PFDC/CAV** - discusses the need to establish communication with the Ministry of Education (MEC) to reinforce the guarantee of the values of freedom of expression and free expression of thought, especially in the academic environments of public institutions of teaching and research.

**Decision n° 227/2021/PFDC/CAV** - refers to the investigation of the existence of any act capable of giving rise to civil-administrative and/or criminal liability as a result of a homotransphobic speech given by television presenter Sikêra Jr.

**Decision n° 256/2021/PFDC/CAV** - deals with IC introduced by PRDC/RS, aimed at investigating Federal Police inspection mechanisms in the face of private security companies, in order to face structural racism, as well as cases of discrimination.

**Decision n° 24/2022/PFDC/CAV** - determines that the Ministry of Women, Family and Human Rights (MMFDH) has a period of 10 days to forward information on the technical note that considers the mandatory vaccination of children against Covid-19 as violation of human rights.

Public Note n° 2/2020/PFDC/MPF - in defense of dialogue in the preservation of the democratic process, as a priority instrument in the search for conciliation and a means of resolving conflicts.

**PFDC'S ACTIONS** 

**Public Note n° 2/2020/GT1/GT13/PFDC/MPF** - in collaboration with the Racial Discrimination Combat and Promotion of Racial Equality and the Human Rights and Businesses WGs, due to the death of João Alberto Silveira Freitas, murdered on the eve of Black Consciousness Day, after being beaten to death on the premises of the Carrefour supermarket, in Porto Alegre (RS).

**Public Note nº 2/2020/GT1/PFDC/MPF** - in collaboration with the *Racial Discrimination Combat and Promotion of Racial Equality WG*, depicts the realization of professional training programs aimed exclusively at black and brown people by the company Magazine Luiza.

Public Note nº 1/2021/GT9/PFDC/MPF - refers to statements by the President of the Republic, Jair Messias Bolsonaro, regarding press freedom.

Joint Public Note 1CCR and PFDC/MPF - defends the appreciation of basic, universal and free education, in view of the Proposed Amendment to the Constitution (PEC) No. 186/2019 which is being discussed in the National Congress, under the pretext of a fiscal adjustment effort.

**Public Note n° 2/2021/PFDC/MPF** - deals with the police action that took place on May 6, 2021 in the community of Jacarezinho, in Rio de Janeiro, which killed more than 20 people.

**Public Note n° 2/2021/GT13/PFDC/MPF** - deals with the importance of Brazil ratifying the Regional Agreement on Access to Information, Public Participation and Access to Justice in Environmental Matters in Latin America and the Caribbean (Escazú Agreement, 2018).

Public Note nº 4/2021/PFDC/MPF - pays attention to violence against black women who hold political office.

**Public Note n° 5/2021/PFDC/MPF** - provides for the need to develop a reception strategy for Afghan men and women seeking refuge in Brazilian territory, due to the humanitarian crisis in Afghanistan.

**Public Note nº 6/2021/PFDC/MPF** - advocates the conclusion of the process of internalization of the Inter-American Convention against Racism, Racial Discrimination and Related Forms of Intolerance, with the necessary publication of the presidential decree of promulgation.

**PFDC'S ACTIONS** 

**Technical Note n° 1/2021** - prepared by Intercameral Agroecologia/MPF WG, addresses the potential negative impacts on the National School Feeding Program (PNAE) and on traditional peoples and communities in view of the urgent voting of the Law (PL) No. 3,292/2020 and No. 4,195/2012, which propose changes to Law No. 11,947/2009.

**Technical Note nº 1/2021/MPF/DPU/DPE-RR/MP-RR** - prepared by MPF, the Prosecutor Service of the State of Roraima, Federal Public Defender's Office (DPU) and Public Defender of the State of Roraima, provides for legal and sanitary aspects for the entry into national territory of foreigners from the Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela, through the borders of the State of Roraima.

**Technical Note n° 1/2021/REL/SCI/PGR** - prepared by the Intercameral WG formed by the 2nd and 5th Coordination and Review Chambers (CCR/MPF), by the International Cooperation Unit (SCI/MPF) and by PFDC, portrays corruption as one of the facilitating aspects of international human trafficking.

**Technical Note n° 3/2021/PFDC/MPF** - in collaboration with the Education and Human Rights and People with Disabilities WGs, points out the unconstitutionality and unconventionality of Decree n° 10.502/2020, which establishes the National Policy on Special Education: Equitable, Inclusive and Lifelong Learning (PNEE 2020).

**Technical Note nº 4/2021/PFDC/MPF** - in collaboration with Pharmaceutical Assistance and High-Cost Medicine TR adopts a position contrary to the approval of Bill No. 948/2021, which facilitates the purchase of vaccines against the new coronavirus (Covid-19) by private companies.

**Technical Note n° 5/2021/PFDC/MPF** - in collaboration with the Woman, Child, Adolescent and Elderly: Protection of Rights WG, defends the use of telemedicine in stages of the procedure for the legal termination of pregnancy resulting from rape, during the AIDS pandemic Covid-19.

**Technical Note n° 6/2021/PFDC/MPF** - in collaboration with the Migration e Refuge WG, suggests the overthrow of the veto given by the mayor of the municipality of Recife (PE) when sanctioning Municipal Law n° 18.798/2021, which establishes the bases for the elaboration of the "Municipal Policy for the Promotion of the Rights of Migrants and Refugees".

Letter n° 93/2021/PFDC/MPF - requests information from the Ministry of Women, Family and Human Rights (MMFDH) on the creation of a working group to review, without the participation of civil society, the National Human Rights Policy (PNDH).

**PFDC'S ACTIONS** 

**Recommendation nº 1/2021/PFDC/MPF -** proposes that MEC refrain from publishing any act or order that determines that the leaders of federal institutions of higher education take measures to prevent and punish supposedly "party-political" acts.

**Representation n° 5/2020/PFDC/MPF -** sustains the occurrence of an act of administrative impropriety against Sérgio Camargo, president of the Palmares Cultural Foundation, and Marco Frenette, general coordinator of the National Center for Information and Reference of Black Culture.

## **3. WORKING GROUPS AND THEMATIC REPORTS**



PFDC System's integrated, coordinated and institutionalized action was the main purpose of this management, with the improvement of work routines in the search for better results for society. The 2020-2022 biennium was marked by the strengthening of PFDC System. During the period, this network in defense of human rights gained new members, increasing from 70 to 152 members of MPU and of State MPs.

Joint work intensified actions in defense of democracy, which must be based on justice, peace and the different manifestations of the right to freedom. In this sense, PFDC sought to build understandings, collectively, regarding the most diverse themes with which human rights are related.

Divided into 13 WGs and two RTs, the members have been working on issues related to the migratory crisis, the fight against homotransphobia and racism, the defense of women's rights, human rights at the corporate level, freedom of expression, adequate food, the forced disappearance of people and the promotion of human rights, among others.

In this context, the composition valued the dedication of each attorney to only one of the WGs and RTs, with a view to ensuring full participation in debates and studies of the topics to which they are urged to express themselves. Even so, each member can contribute to all discussions involving PFDC's activities, due to the thematic transversality of human rights. It is important to point out that the work of these members at PFDC is voluntary.

The contribution of each member makes PFDC a stronger institution in the defense of citizens' rights.

#### **3. WORKING GROUPS AND THEMATIC REPORTS**



With the publication of PFDC Ordinance n° 6/2021, more than 150 members began to assist in monitoring issues such as combating racial discrimination, land reform, combating torture, migration and refuge, people with disabilities, human rights and business, LGBTI+ population.

The ordinance clarifies that PFDC operates exclusively in the extrajudicial scope, which requires frequent and direct dialogue with the other branches of MPU and with MPs of the States.

With this new composition, PFDC's coordination initiatives now have the collaboration of MP members from 21 States and the four branches of MPU - which covers more than 80% of the Brazilian MP. In fact, it is the first time that this network for the protection of rights has the participation of representatives of MPM.

On the following pages, it is possible to learn about the initiatives developed and monitored by these groups, including the preparation of public and technical notes; suggestions of recommendations and information requests; public meetings and webinars.





WORKGROUP 1 (WG1)

## Guidelines

Racism is one of the central problems of Brazilian society. Slave activity developed during Brazil as a colony and Brazil as an empire left indelible marks on the reality of the black population. Untying the knot of racial inequality is, or should be, one of the most important objectives of the Republic. Despite legal and social advances, statistics show that abuses against black and brown people in Brazil continue with alarming force.

The WG has focused on this problem. Currently, the group acts to strengthen public policies to protect and promote racial equality, as well as to recognize the social and cultural contribution of the black population in Brazil. In addition, it also works to combat exclusionary or repressive practices or public policies that harm individuals or groups based on their race, ethnicity, nationality and religion, or other related social categories, and makes suggestions for improvements in the implementation of the Racial Equality Statute (Law n° 12.288/2010).

Public Note nº 2/2020/GT/PFDC was issued about the realization of professional training programs aimed exclusively at black and brown people, by the company Magazine Luiza. In the document, PFDC emphasized the need to observe the measured and proportional use of force in Public Security actions.

#### Public Note nº 4/2021/PFDC/MPF

JUL

was issued in honor of the National Day of Tereza de Benguela and Black Women, instituted by Law No. 12,987/2014, and celebrated annually on July 25, inspired by the International Day of AfroLatin-Caribbean Women. Elaborated together with the Women, Children, Adolescents and Elderly People: Protection of Rights WG, the note highlighted the struggle of black women against gender oppression, exploitation and racism, especially in the field of representative democracy. The WG sent a request to the PFDC to hold a meeting with the Federal Ombudsman for Human Rights (ONDH) and the MPF Internal Ombudsman to seek to improve channels for denouncing political violence against black women at all stages of the electoral process. An agenda was also requested with representatives of the CNDH and its Permanent Commission for the Promotion and Defense of Women, the LGBTI Population and the Promotion of Racial Equality to address the aforementioned topic.

# **3.2 LAND REFORM AND LAND CONFLICTS**



#### WORKING GROUP 2 (WG2)

## Guidelines

The latifundium has been a Brazilian reality since colonial times. Already in 1534, under the auspices of the Portuguese reign, there was the first donation of large plots of land to private individuals, under the condition of planting in the given place, known as sesmaria. This practice remained until 1850, with the approval of the Land Law during the reign of D. Pedro II. The Land Law itself maintained the stimulus for land concentration in the hands of a few landowners, creating difficulties for small farmers to access land. The echoes of that legislation reverberate to the present day.

According to the 2017 agricultural census, published by IBGE, rural establishments with an area equal to or greater than 1,000 hectares represented only 1% of all properties in the countryside. However, they accounted for 47% of the total area used. This contrasted with rural properties of less than 10 hectares, which made up 50% of all properties, but occupy only 2% of the exploited rural area in Brazil.

The disparity in the distribution and use of rural land has been accompanied by conflicts in the countryside, one of the great problems of the Brazilian reality accompanied by the WG Agrarian Reform and Land Conflicts. Thus, it acts in the monitoring of public policies capable of facing these issues and presents legal subsidies for the implementation of agrarian reform, in addition to preventing and combating violence in the countryside.

As of May 2022, PFDC filed an administrative proceeding to accompany the Argument of Non-Compliance with a Fundamental Precept (ADPF) n° 828, which suspended administrative or judicial measures that resulted in dislodgement, evictions, forced removals or repossession of vulnerable populations since a state of public calamity was established due to the Covid-19 pandemic.

PFDC, accepting the WG's suggestion, sent official letters to several bodies to clarify the authorization of the use of the National Public Security Force (FNSP), in support of the Ministry of Agriculture, Livestock and Supply (Mapa), in the Incra settlements in the municipalities of Prado and of Mucuri, in the State of Bahia. PFDC asked Incra for information related to agrarian reform, the autarchy's budget and public lands. The demand arose due to news in the press that Incra's budget proposal for the year 2021 practically extinguished the funds for finalistic programs, such as Technical Assistance and Rural Extension and Land Regularization. DEC

PFDC urged the National Council of Justice (CNJ) to reactivate the Forum on Land Matters, created by Resolution No. 110/2010. This measure would strengthen inter-institutional dialogue and dialogue with civil society regarding land conflicts. In response, through Official Letter No. 198/2021, the President of the CNJ informed that Resolution No. 110/2010 had been revoked and that actions on these issues were carried out by the National Observatory on Environmental, Economic and Social Issues of High Complexity and Large Impact and Repercussion, established jointly with the National Council of Prosecution Services (CNMP).



## **ACTIONS TAKEN**

## 2021 • JAN

Launch of the **Agrarian Reform and Formalization of** Access to Land Guide, with basic information on the different possibilities for formalizing access to land within the scope of agrarian reform, in the light of the 1988 Constitution and the governing legislation. The material brings the regulations related to the theme, clarifies the forms of regularization of rural properties in the agrarian reform and describes the instruments used, such as the concession of use contract (CCU), the concession of real right of use (CDRU) and the domain title.

PFDC forwarded to the PRDCs Recommendations nº 6 and nº 7, of 2020, written by the Holder of the 2nd Office of the PRDC in Araguaína (TO). In them, INCRA was urged to no longer postpone inspections of rural properties registered in the name of the Union, in view of analyzing the availability of using these lands in agrarian reform settlements. PFDC suggested that prosecutors in the rest of the country adopt a similar procedure in similar cases.

Members of the Working Group and the Federal Court of Accounts – Brazil (TCU) met to discuss **Decision n**° 727/2020/TCU. At the time, the group aimed to understand how the technical area of the Court of Accounts observed the execution of the aforementioned decision about problems in the Terra Legal Program. This contact resulted from the mismatch between the Court's recommendations and the actions taken by the Executive.

PFDC recommended that PRDCs adopt, when applicable, a similar procedure to ACP n° 1000430-69.2021.4.01.3803. presented by the PRDC in Uberlândia (MG) to the 3rd Civil and Criminal Federal Court of the respective Judicial Subsection. The ACP "aims to guarantee to the families of rural workers who live in the Maringá/Monte Castelo Settlement Project the implementation of the right to land, housing, work and a dignified life [...] keeping in that place families who have been carrying out works and services for two decades in a property without land regularization".

Meeting with TCU, INCRA and the Brazilian Office of the Comptroller General (CGU) to discuss the Terra Legal and Titula Brasil programs. On the agenda, there were some gaps of the program, in addition to the consolidation of data and the resolution of doubts. A Public meeting on the bills dealing with land regularization being processed in the Chamber of Deputies and the Federal Senate (PL n° 2633/2020 and PL n° 510/2021). Representatives of the Institute of the Man and the Environment of the Amazon (Imazon), the Federal University of Minas Gerais, the Landless Rural Workers Movement (MST) and the Pastoral Land Commission (Comissão Pastoral da Terra) participated in the event.

PFDC, at the request of the Working Group, requested information from the Ministry of Justice and Public Security (MJSP) about an action plan for the FNSP in Rondônia, an action authorized by Ordinance nº 235/2021/MJSP. The request was based on art. 4, § 3, of Decree n° 5.289/2004. The MJSP, through Official Letter n° 144/2021, informed that the administrative process had documents classified as preparatory, as it was an operation still in progress, which is why it was not possible to grant the requested access.

A Public meeting to discuss a study on possessory claims in the new Civil Procedure Code (CPC). Sponsored by the CNJ, the research was coordinated by the professor at the Institute of Teaching and Research Insper (Instituto de Ensino e Pesquisa Insper) Bianca Margarita Damin Tavolari, with the objective of understanding whether the changes in the 2015 CPC caused changes in collective possession actions of real estate.

## **3.3 PREVENTION AND** COMBAT OF TORTURE



#### WORKING GROUP 3 (WG 3)

## Guidelines

The practice of torture permeates Brazilian history. It is present in the harsh physical punishments applied to slaves; in the lashes inflicted on sailors in the early 20th century; in the tortures suffered by opponents of the Getúlio Vargas Government, or by antagonists to the military regime in force in the 60s and 80s of the last century. It is an ancient and well-known evil in our society.

The 1988 Constitution prohibits torture under any circumstances. In addition, in 1997, Law n° 9.455 was passed, criminalizing the practice and defining penalties of up to 21 years for those who commit it.

Despite this, torture continues to be applied by State agents. There are numerous cases of violence against suspects during police arrests, or even against prisoners in state custody. In an attempt to remedy this situation, and to honor its commitment to the UN, Brazil created the National System for the Prevention and Combat of Torture (SNPCT), through Law n° 12.847/2013. The SNPCT seeks to create state mechanisms to combat torture and other degrading treatments.

In this context, the Prevention and Combat of Torture Working Group has as a guideline to act in the improvement of the SNPCT, especially for the creation and implementation in all federative states of the State Mechanism for the Prevention and Combat of Torture (MEPCT). The creation of a state committee and mechanisms was even the object of a coordinated action that urged dozens of PRDCs to promote Conduct Adjustment Terms (TACs) with local governments and other public bodies.

PFDC sent an Official Letter to the International Affairs Office of the MMFDH for clarification on compliance with precautionary measures granted by the IACHR in favor of: - persons deprived of their liberty in the Central Prison of Porto Alegre in Rio Grande do Sul (PM n° 8-13). - of adolescents deprived of their liberty in Socio-Educational Care Units for Male Internment in the State of Ceará (PM n° 60-15). - by the military policeman André Luiz Moreira da Silva (PM n° 1498-18). - of adolescents deprived of their liberty at the Centro de Atendimento Socioeducativo ao Adolescente Cedro (CASA Cedro), in São Paulo (PM n° 302-15). PFDC asked the MP/RJ for detailed information on the inclusion of the name of military police officer André Luiz Moreira da Silva in the Prosecution Service's Program for Locating and the Identification of Missing Persons (Sinalid). It also requested information on the existence of an investigative procedure that either has been initiated, is in progress or has already been concluded, regarding the disappearance of that person. PFDC then requested clarification from the Deliberative Council of the Program for the Protection of Victims and Threatened Witnesses of the State of Rio de Janeiro (Provita/RJ) on the possible adoption of protective measures for the relatives of the aforementioned police officer.

With regard to the precautionary measures granted by the IACHR, in accordance with the WG's suggestion, PFDC requested explanations from the following public bodies and entities: - the National Mechanism for the Prevention and Combat of Torture (MNPCT) to verify that the inspection in the socio-educational units had already taken place; - to the Public Defender's Office of the State of Ceará requesting them to inform if there had been an inspection of the precautionary measures imposed by the IACHR, with regard to the protection of children and adolescents; to the Inspector general of the internment units referred to by PM 60-15 for the confirmation or not of the information present in the MMFDH Report on the internment units in Ceará; and - to the Prosecution Service of the State of Ceará to question whether that body had already investigated, or was investigating, the complaints registered by the IACHR.

PFDC launched a coordinated action to encourage the implementation of Committees and Mechanisms for the **Prevention and Combat of Torture** in all federative states with the purpose of complying with international conventions and protocols in force in the Brazilian legal system. An official letter was sent to the PRDCs of 21 states and the Federal District (DF), based on a TAC signed between the PRDC/AC, the Acre government and other public bodies.

## **3.4 MIGRATION** AND REFUGE



#### WORKING GROUP 4 (WG4)

## Guidelines

Today human movements occur on a scale never seen before. Whether motivated by political issues, economic reasons or natural disasters, millions of people cross borders in search of better living conditions. According to the International Organization for Migration (IOM), there were 281 million international migrants around the globe in 2020. This is equivalent to the sum of the populations of Brazil and France.

A significant part of international migrants are victims of humanitarian tragedies, needing to seek refuge outside their home countries. It is up to host nations to look for the best ways to help these people. Brazil has stood out especially in welcoming Venezuelan, Syrian and Congolese refugees, according to UNHCR. In 2018, the Federal Government launched Operação Acolhida, an initiative aimed at helping the large number of people from Venezuela, who were fleeing the difficult social, political and economic conditions of that country. The year 2021 ended with 287,000 Venezuelan refugees regularized under the operation.

Thus, the Migration and Refuge WG provided technical support on regulations that deal with the closing of borders. In addition, it has followed up and monitored the continuity of Operação Acolhida, in order to keep it in line with the principles and rules that govern the matter.

PFDC sent an official letter to the operational coordinator of **Operação Acolhida**, requesting: the monthly budget allocation forecast for 2020 and 2021; - which transition measures were intended to be adopted for the next public policies to be developed in case of the termination of Operação Acolhida, as well as which national and/or international actors were involved in this transition and the measures that the Union intended to continue fulfilling for its obligation to develop public policies to welcome the migrant and refugee population of Venezuela, in cooperation with the States and Municipalities, civil society entities, the private sector, international organizations and other actors.

PFDC sent an official letter to Conare requesting the transcript of the 150th Plenary Meeting and the **criteria used** to reject asylum requests. At the ordinary meeting, held on November 20, 2020, 17 asylum requests had been reportedly rejected without an eligibility interview, as they were, in theory, manifestly unfounded requests.

Renewal of the collaboration agreement for the protection of migrants not admitted at Guarulhos Airport, in São Paulo, originally signed in 2019. The agreement created **conditions for** humanized care for migrants who arrived in Brazil through that airport, but were not admitted in the country. In 2020, 297 people had been assisted by services established from this collaboration agreement. Members of PFDC, UNHCR, DPU, the National Secretariat of Justice and the City Hall of Guarulhos participated in the ceremony.

A Webinar commemorating Immigrant Day, on the theme <u>"Migration and Refuge Law"</u>, as part of the Citizenship Encounters Project. Researchers from the Federal University of Santa Maria and the Federal University of Paraná, as well as the coordinator of the WG participated.

Preparation of <u>Technical Note n°</u> <u>6/2021/PFDC/MPF</u>, suggesting overriding the veto given by the mayor of the city of Recife (PE) when sanctioning Municipal Law N° 18.798/2021, which established the bases for the elaboration of the Municipal Promotion Policy on the Rights of Migrants and Refugees. Publication of **Public Note n° 5/2021/PFDC/MPF** on the need to develop a reception strategy for Afghan women and Afghans seeking future refuge in Brazilian territory, due to the humanitarian crisis in Afghanistan. On that occasion, the Brazilian government was asked to take an urgent position on the reception of refugees from that country. He highlighted the need for joint action by the Federal Government, at least with the participation of the MJSP, MRE and Conare.

Members of PFDC and of the Auschwitz Institute for the Prevention of Genocide and Mass Atrocities met to discuss the results of a research that focused on the situation of young Venezuelan migrants in Boa Vista (RR). The **migratory crisis** has been accompanied by the PFDC System, notably with regard to the cut of resources for *Operação Acolhida*, conducted by the Brazilian Army since 2018, in the cities of Manaus (AM), Boa Vista and Pacaraima (RR). ### **3.5 EDUCATION AND** HUMAN RIGHTS



#### WORKING GROUP 5 (WG5)

### Guidelines

Education, a right of all and a duty of the State and the family, will be promoted and encouraged with the collaboration of society, aiming at the full development of the person, their preparation for the exercise of citizenship and their qualification for work. This is how art. 205 of the Federal Constitution states it.

Since the advent of the Citizen Constitution, Brazil has made progress in reducing illiteracy. According to the Brazilian Institute of Geography and Statistics (IBGE), in 1988, 18.9% of people aged 15 or over, around 17 million Brazilians could not read or write. In 2019, this percentage decreased to 6.6% or 11 million people. Despite the significant reduction, the number of illiterates is still expressive.

Added to this is the fact that the educational system faces serious difficulties in the formation of young people in primary education. In 2018, the International Student Assessment Program (Pisa) indicated that 43% of 15-year-old Brazilian students were below the minimum level of proficiency in reading, mathematics and science. The average for the countries of the Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development (OECD), the entity that organizes the test, was 13% in this regard.

The *Education and Human Rights WG* aims to subsidize the work of PFDC, with regard to sensitive issues related to the protection and promotion of a public, democratic, plural, secular, universal, humanized and qualified education.

The Permanent Commission on Education (Copeduc), of the National Human Rights Group (GNDH/CNPG), the 1st Chamber of Coordination and Review of MPF (1CCR) and PFDC, in a joint Public Note, expressed deep concern about the content of PEC nº 186/2019, which was being processed in the National Congress under the pretext of fiscal adjustment effort. Art. 4 of the aforementioned PEC extinguished the constitutional allocation of minimum resources for education by the Union, States and Municipalities. The proposal, promulgated by the National Congress, represented not only a setback in terms of Brazilian educational policy, but also the emptying of achievements. An example of this is the permanent character given to the Fund for the Maintenance and Development of Basic Education and for the Valorization of Education Professionals (Fundeb). Without the obligation of minimum transfers to education, according to the note, Fundeb would lose its effectiveness as a financing instrument.

PFDC formulated Recommendation n°1/2021/PFDC/MPF for MEC, with support from the "Education and Human Rights WG" and the "Freedoms: Conscience, Belief and Expression WG". In it, the ministry was oriented to refrain from issuing acts or orders determining the directors of the Federal Institutions of Higher Education the prevention and punishment of supposedly political-partisan acts. The text of PFDC opposed Recommendation n° 133/2019, issued by the PRDC in Goiás, which advised MEC in a completely opposite direction.

PFDC issued <u>Technical Note n°</u> 3/2021, which pointed out the unconstitutionality and unconventionality of Decree N° 10.502/2020, which established the National Policy on Special Education: Equitable, Inclusive and with a Lifelong Learning. The document was prepared with the support of the Education and Human Rights WG and the Persons with Disabilities WG.

Meeting with representatives of the National Campaign for the **Right to Education**. On the agenda, the issue of the militarization of schools movement. The sharing of reports related to the topic was determined for information, knowledge and future actions. PFDC sent an Official Letter to MEC and to the Anísio Teixeira National Institute of Educational Studies and Research (Inep) on the establishment of an ideological review commission for the **National High School Exam (Enem)**.

After articulation of PFDC, registrations were opened for the selection process to fill vacancies for members of MPF interested in participating in the **"Fundaments in the Prevention of Massive Atrocities"** Course, promoted by the Auschwitz Institute. AUG

### **ACTIONS TAKEN**

A member of the WG spoke out at the public hearing promoted by STF in the records of the Direct Action of Unconstitutionality (ADI) n° 6.590, which deals with Decree N° 10.502/2020. In his speech, he reaffirmed PFDC's position issued in **Technical Note n° 3/2021/PFDC/MPF**, which points out the segregationist character of the rule.

PFDC recommended that Inep refrain from creating a Review Commission for the **Basic Education** Assessment processes – Items Assessment, as well as any and all initiatives of the same nature. SEP

PFDC sent an Official Letter to FNDE, requesting the forwarding of detailed and updated information about the inspection regarding non-compliance with art. 14 of Law n° 11.947/2009. 2022 o----

Fourth webinar of the cycle of debates on online violence, promoted within the scope of the Citizenship Encounters Project. The event addressed strategies to prevent hate speech. As a spokesperson: the director of the Educational Policy Program at the Auschwitz Institute and a member of the Freedoms: Conscience, Belief and Expression WG. Panelists debated the importance of preparing people as de facto citizens, respectful of human rights, as well as the need to foster critical discourse and knowledge of human rights in schools, and not just subjects that only aim to enter the job market, as in the last reform of Brazilian education.

### **3.6 PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES**



#### WORKING GROUP 6 (WG6)

### Guidelines

The Federal Constitution establishes that the three spheres of public power are responsible for taking care of health and providing public assistance, as well as the protection and guarantees of persons with disabilities. In addition, the constitutional text, in several points, establishes the need for social integration of the disabled population, in order to guarantee them the possibility of a life with dignity, productivity and welfare.

According to IBGE, 8.4% of Brazilians over 2 years of age had some type of disability in 2019. This corresponds to more than 17 million people, which is equivalent to the population of the state of Rio de Janeiro. The Persons with Disabilities WG's guideline is to promote and defend the full and equitable exercise of all human rights and fundamental freedoms of this population, with an emphasis on fighting any form of discrimination (Decree n° 6.949/2009), as well as respecting its inclusion (Law n° 13.146/2015) and accessibility (Decree n° 5.296/2004).

The group's work has involved a survey with Federal Universities and Federal Institutes to verify the effective implementation of inclusive education centers. In addition, the WG wrote Technical Note N° 3/2021 on the unconstitutionality and unconventionality of Decree n° 10.502/2020, which opened the possibility of segregating students with disabilities in schools or classes apart from those established in regular education.

PFDC sent an official letter to the National Council for the Rights of Persons with Disabilities (Conade), requesting information on the actions "adopted by this Council with the Executive Branch in order to obtain the regulation of article 2 of the Brazilian Inclusion Law (Biopsychosocial Assessment of Disability), in force for more than five years". Another request was the presentation of all the material that, in that period, had been produced by Conade, regarding the aforementioned regulation.

Preparation of **Technical Note** n° 3/2021/PFDC/MPF. supporting the unconstitutionality and unconventionality of **Decree n**<sup>o</sup> 10.502/2020. The aforementioned technical note was sent to the Prosecutor General of the Republic, with the purpose of subsidizing the

manifestation in ADI nº 6.590. The document was also presented at a public hearing on the subject, held by STF, on August 24, in the form of videoconferencing.

#### In a coordinated action, PFDC encouraged the adoption of solutions for any obstacles encountered in the accessibility of persons with disabilities at airports, preferably through the signing of TACs with the managers of these locations. The minimum parameter would be to obtain boarding and disembarkation assistance technology on aircraft at any time. This measure was based on the TAC with Vitória da Conquista Airport (BA).

PFDC expressed concern about the fact that the actions of the Interinstitutional Working Group (GTI) on the Single Model for Biopsychosocial Assessment of Disability, established by **Decree nº 10.415/2020**, were being developed without observing the necessary representation of persons with disabilities.

#### The WG coordinator participated in a <u>public hearing at the House</u> <u>of Representatives (CD)</u> to

debate the recommendations made to the Brazilian State in the third cycle of the Universal Periodic Review (2017-2021) in relation to the rights of persons with disabilities, within the scope of the Parliamentary Observatory of UPR.

PFDC sent official letters to the National Secretariat for the Rights of the Person with Disabilities and to Conade, requesting, respectively, a full copy of the final report of the GTI's activities on the Single Model for **Biopsychosocial** Assessment of Disability and the studies that supported the approval, through its Resolution n° 01/2020, of the Modified Brazilian Functionality Index (IFBr-M), in particular the report produced by the University of Brasília (UnB).

A circular letter was sent to PRDCs encouraging the investigation of the lack of reservation of vacancies for black candidates and persons with disabilities to access the position of Translator and Interpreter of Libras at the Federal Institutes of Education, Science and Technology located in the various units of the Federation. The initiative was based on the TAC signed with the Federal Institute of Science and Technology of Minas Gerais (MG).

PFDC asked the National Secretariat for the Rights of Persons with Disabilities (SNDPD) for information and documents that supported the GTI's final report on the single model of Biopsychosocial Assessment of Disability.

### **3.7 MEMORY AND TRUTH**



#### WORKING GROUP 7 (WG7)

### Guidelines

The Military Dictatorship installed in Brazil between 1964 and 1985 had as main characteristics the violent repression of its opponents – including the use of torture and murder – the curtailment of individual liberties and guarantees, in addition to the erosion of democracy.

There were at least 20.000 people tortured during the period. The National Truth Commission (CNV) recognized, in 2014, the death of 224 people and the disappearance of another 210 by State agents during those 21 years. More than a thousand bones of victims of the dictatorship, discovered in the clandestine cemetery of Perus, in São Paulo, await identification.



The crimes perpetrated by the State during the military regime are one of the darkest chapters in Brazilian history, and cannot be forgotten. Volkswagen in Brasil, for example, cooperated with the military regime established here. It collaborated with political repression, including from a financial point of view, even helping in the temporary disappearance of some of its employees. In view of this scenario, the Memory and Truth WG aims to act in compliance with Law n° 9.140/1995 (Special Commission on Political Deaths and Disappearances - CEMDP), Law N° 10.559/2002 (Amnesty Commission) and Law n° 12.528/2011 (National Truth Commission). The WG has worked on cases involving the disappearance of children during the period of the Military Dictatorship, the promotion of places of memory in the country and the inapplicability of the Amnesty Law in the civil and administrative spheres, in cases of serious violations of human rights.

Official Letters sent to Capes and CNPq urging these bodies to promote funding and the granting of scholarships for research on human rights violations committed during the period of the Military Dictatorship.

PFDC sent an Official Letter to members of the Federal Prosecution Service (MPF), informing them about the establishment of an administrative procedure aimed at continuing the research on the authorship of violent acts in emblematic cases (JK, João Goulart and Anísio Teixeira).

PFDC promoted a webinar with the theme **"Corporate Transition Justice"**, with the support of the Human Rights and Business WG and the Memory and Truth WG. PFDC sent an official letter to the Commission for the Defense of Fundamental Rights CNMP requesting information on possible cases of disappearance of children or adolescents during the Military Dictatorship registered in Sinalid, and, in case of an affirmative answer, the available data, in particular name(s) of missing person(s) and location of the event.

A survey on information about institutions and bodies that already have a project in progress to monitor compliance with the decisions of the CNV and the Inter-American Court of Human Rights in matters of Transitional Justice.

#### A survey on the procedures established in the MPF to monitor the implementation of places of memory - a term used in the field of human rights that refers to the different means of celebration and worship of the memories of victims subjected to serious violence and/or

suppression of rights.

PFDC advised the Federal prosecutors working in the area of citizenship to communicate to the MP and the family of the alleged victims about the filing of new civil and criminal actions related to transitional justice, emphasizing that the communication should be made prior to the filing of the actions in what concerns to family members. Meeting with CEMDP to address concerns about the interruption of projects, the review of decisions and understandings, mass dismissals, memory measures, commission extinction and stoppage of activities. NOV

PRDC/TO requested information on the situation of a monument designed by architect Oscar Niemeyer and built to honor the Guerrilha do Araguaia, located in the municipality of Xambioá, in the micro-region of Bico do Papagaio, in Tocantins. The official letters sent to the Municipality of Xambioá and to the Agency for the Development of Tourism, Culture and Creative Economy responded to PFDC's request.

Official letters were forwarded to members of the MPF in Rio de Janeiro, Rio Grande do Sul, Minas Gerais and Tocantins informing the willingness of the Memory and Truth WG to collaborate in investigations related to places of memory.

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### **3.8 LGBTQIA+ POPULATION:** PROTECTION OF RIGHTS



WORKING GROUP 8 (WG8)

### Guidelines

The Brazilian Association of Gays, Lesbians, Bisexuals, Transvestites and Transsexuals estimates the LGBTI+ population in Brazil at 18 million people. This represents 8.4% of the total population of the country, but this is an imprecise figure, as there are no official numbers that capture the variety of gender cuts that exist today.

Although crimes of homophobia and transphobia were considered imprescriptible and non-bailable by STF in 2019, Brazil is a country where there is strong prejudice regarding people's sexual orientation and gender. This is reflected in repeated cases of verbal, psychological and physical violence against the LGBTQIA+ population.

Our country is at the top of the ranking of the nations that kill the most transgender people in the world. According to the organization Transgender Europe (TGEU), of the 375 murders of trans people that took place in 2021, 125, or a third of the global total, took place here.

It is, therefore, increasingly necessary to build protective devices for these people. In this way, the LGBTI+ Population: Protection of Rights WG works to promote and defend the citizenship and human rights of the lesbian, gay, bisexual, transvestite, transsexual, intersexual and other sexual orientations, gender identities and expressions.

Meeting to discuss representation of the National Women's Movement of the MP, which suggested the adoption of gender, race and diversity equity initiatives in the Brazilian MP. Among them: - recognition of the social name of transgender people who use MPF services, as well as members, servants, interns and outsourced personnel who so desire: - use of the bathroom by transgender people according to the sex they identify with; - establishment of the Gender and Race Steering Committee; - Interlocution with social movements, within the scope of the WG.

PFDC organized, within the scope of the **Citizenship Encounters** Project, a webinar with the theme "The criminalization of homotransphobia: deviations from the effectiveness of the STF decision in ADO 26 and MI 4773". The debate revolved around STE's determination for homophobic and transphobic conduct to be framed in the typification of the Racism Law, until there is a specific law on the matter.

Establishment of an administrative procedure aimed at monitoring public policies for the institution of registration and official database of crimes of homotransphobic motivation practiced in Brazil. AUG

Based on Joint Recommendation n° 03/2021, prepared by MPF/AC, DPU, MP/AC and the Public Defender's Office of that state, PFDC asked the PRDCs to recommend the following actions to public security bodies in their regions: - training and qualification of public security agents in the LGBTI+ theme; - inclusion of data related to LGBTI+ people in police records (gender identity, sexual orientation, social name, etc.), in order to enable the collection of statistical data on LGBTphobic violence in the states; - broadening of the focus of investigation of crimes of domestic and family violence.

PFDC sent an official letter urging the Superior School of the Prosecution Service of the Union (ESMPU) to include, in events related to issues on rights of LGBTI+ people, the participation of academics and professionals representing this population. In Technical Note n° 3/2022/PFDC/MPF, PFDC took a position on the prohibition of the use of this language by state and federal governments, in addition to clarifying fundamental aspects involving the topic and its importance in the process of visibility and equal treatment of minorities. The technical note also proposes to contribute to the debates to be promoted within the scope of the Legislative Power in the appreciation of PL n° 5.198/2020, which is being processed in the House of Representatives. The PL aims to expressly prohibit the use, in school curricula and public notices, of new forms of inflection of gender and number of words in the Portuguese language. Among the recipients of the note are the president of the House of Representatives, the president of the Committee on Work, Administration and Public Service (CTASP); and the rapporteur of the project in the commission.

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# **3.9 WOMAN, CHILD, ADOLESCENT** AND ELDERLY: PROTECTION OF RIGHTS

#### WORKING GROUP 9 (WG9)

### **Guidelines**

Women, children, adolescents and the elderly form a peculiar segment of the Brazilian population, due to their positions of vulnerability in society. All these categories received special legislative attention, in order to provide them with greater protection against the threats present in the Brazilian social arrangement.

The Maria da Penha Law, the Child and Adolescent Statute (ECA), as well as the Elderly Statute are the most relevant examples of norms used to protect these groups in our society. These three laws – and others – show themselves as a civilizing mark in our society. Although constantly infringed, its existence allows advances in the care of people who, for circumstantial reasons, are unable to protect themselves.

Faced with these hypervulnerabilities, the Woman, Child, Adolescent and Elderly: Protection of Rights WG was created, with the aim of strengthening public policies for these groups, including fighting violence in its various forms, monitoring the use of resources from the National Fund for the Rights of Children and Adolescents and the activities of the National Council for the Rights of Children and Adolescents (Conanda).

PFDC has also been working towards the approval of the Draft Legislative Decree (PDC) n° 863/2017, which deals with the internalization of the Inter-American Convention on the Protection of the Human Rights of the Elderly.

A technical note was sent to the Prosecutor General of the Republic (PGR), in order to subsidize him in a manifestation in ADPF 737 and ADI n° 6.552, which deal with Ordinance n° 2.282/2020, of the Ministry of Health (MS). According to WG members, the ordinance established a series of guidelines on abortion in case of rape, which contradicts basic guidelines for the protection and care of children and women, fixed in the Federal Constitution and in Law nº 10.778/2003.

#### NOV

The Citizenship Encounters Project was launched with five virtual seminars on violence against women, alluding to the 16 days of women's activism. Free and open to anyone, the meetings brought together public authorities, experts on the subject and the general public in order to improve reflections and discussions on the relationship between racial discrimination, sexism and the justice system. Webinars were held on November 26 and 30, December 2, 4 and 9.

An official letter was sent to the MRE, requesting the provision of a copy of the information and documents sent by the Brazilian State to the IACHR in the Precautionary Measures – MC n° 8-13, 60-15, 1498-18, 302-15 and 1358-18. An official letter was sent to the Institute of Economic Research Foundation, requesting information about the "BRIEF Project -COVID-19, social distancing and violence against women in Brazil".

The document was forwarded to the PRDC, the Minister of Health, the director-president of the National Health Surveillance Agency (Anvisa) and the president of the Federal Council of Medicine (CFM).

Public Note nº 4/2021/PFDC/MPF in honor of the National Day of Tereza de Benguela and the Black Woman, established by Law nº 12.987/2014, and celebrated annually on July 25, inspired by the International Day of Afro-Latin-Caribbean Women. The note, produced in conjunction with the Racial Discrimination Combat and Promotion of Racial Equality WG, highlighted the struggle of black women against gender oppression, exploitation and racial discrimination, especially in the field of representative democracy. The document highlighted the urgency of a public policy suited for the new times, which prevents setbacks and provides an increase in the number of candidacies from black people, especially black women, who wish to see themselves represented in these spaces of power.



# **3.10 SOCIAL SECURITY AND** POPULATION IN STREET SITUATIONS



WORKING GROUP 10 (WG10)

### Guidelines

The concept of citizenship necessarily permeates the recognition and implementation of welfare rights regarding the Welfare State. From this premise, social security involves a broad protection system, provided for in art. 194 of the Federal Constitution, which requires public intervention to ensure the effectiveness of the rights to health, social security and social assistance for all who need it.

The presence of the State, through social security, is essential to reduce social inequalities. IBGE data shows that, in 2020, 12 million people lived in the extreme poverty line. One of the main evidences of this Brazilian social inequality is the reality of the homeless population. Estimates from the Institute for Applied Economic Research (IPEA) indicate that the homeless population increased by more than 140% between 2012 and 2020, from 92.000 people to 221.000 in this period.

In the request addressed to the Ministry of Citizenship, three aspects are mentioned. The first one aims to identify which bodies are directly dealing with the issue, as well as the current composition of these sectors, if any. Another point seeks to collect information on the latest quantitative and qualitative indicators, which should help in mapping the situation of the homeless population in Brazil. The last one aims to investigate the progress of existing federal government programs related to improving the living conditions of this population. All currently available data related to the issue were requested by PFDC to IBGE.

# **3.11 FREEDOMS: CONSCIENCE,** BELIEF AND EXPRESSION



#### WORKING GROUP 11 (WG11)

### **Guidelines**

Between 1964 and 1985, freedom of expression was severely curtailed by the Military Dictatorship in Brazil. Artistic works were censored, as were journalistic articles; popular demonstrations against the regime were violently repressed by security forces. With the end of the military period, the 1988 Constitution guaranteed everyone the right to freedom of expression, as well as free expression of conscience and belief.

The constitutional text presented itself as an undeniable advance in the field of freedoms, but, in practice, there are still problems to overcome. Hate speech and intolerance, amplified by the use of digital platforms, reprimands to social movements, and the consolidation of freedom of belief, remain a challenge in Brazil. The places of worship of religions of African origin are often depredated and their faithful attacked by members of other religious denominations.

In <u>Public Note n° 3/2020/PFDC/MPF</u>, PFDC stated that the creation of lists cataloging the opinion of journalists and citizens in general is characterized as indirect censorship. The note referred to the disclosure, by the press, that the federal government monitors the performance and positioning of journalists, bloggers and digital influencers. According to the article, the report produced would also suggest actions to be taken by the federal government in relation to each of those mentioned.

PFDC issued Public Note n° 1/2021/PFDC/MPF repudiating verbal attacks made by the President of the Republic, Jair Bolsonaro, aimed at the press on December 27. In addition to the Federal Constitution, which guarantees freedom of expression and of the press, the document emphasized that "the IACHR is forceful in relation to state obligations to prevent and investigate acts that may be considered frightening to journalists, which is why the practice of acts of this nature by any Brazilian public agent is unacceptable". It also stated that it is the obligation of transparency of public managers to provide clear, objective and accurate information about the use of public resources.

PFDC recommended MEC that it refrain from issuing any act or order that determines the directors of Federal Institutions of Higher Education measures to prevent and punish allegedly "partisan-political" acts, similar to the revoked Circular Letter n° 4/2021/DIFES /SESU/ SESU-MEC, of February 7, 2021 The WG coordinator participated in the CDHM-CD, within the scope of the Parliamentary Observatory of the UPR. On the occasion, the participants examined compliance with the recommendations made to Brazil to guarantee the rights of free expression and organization. Among the topics covered were technical notes issued by PFDC that aim to contribute to respect for fundamental freedoms of democracy, such as freedom of the press, assembly and organization.

The Public Ethics Commission of the Federal Executive Branch complied with PFDC's recommendation and sent a message to all federal public agents in which it emphasizes that exercising a position or function in the public service does not deprive its holders of the right to participate in debates involving collective life. According to PFDC, the establishment of administrative procedures cannot be used as an inhibiting effect on the free flow of ideas.

#### SEP

In a virtual meeting, the UPR Parliamentary Observatory verified Brazil's compliance with recommendations to guarantee the safety of human rights defenders. During participation in the meeting, the WG coordinator recalled that the Brazilian State is more than 14 years behind in the preparation of a plan that addresses the issue, defended as essential the participation of civil society in the preparation of the document. The protection of human rights defenders in Brazil is supported by Decree N° 6.044/2007 and Decree N° 9.937/2019.


PFDC promoted another cycle of webinars as part of the Citizenship Encounters Project. In the months of October and November, the theme *Freedom of Expression* was debated from four perspectives: hate speech, religious intolerance, press and academic freedom. The meetings took place on October 7 and 21, November 5 and 18. PFDC asked the CNJ's Permanent Commission on Social Policies and Citizen Development to clarify the existence of a specific initiative or a resolution perspective to establish goals and/or actions to be triggered to obtain effective practical results, within the scope of the Judicial Branch, particularly with regard to the full exercise of religious freedoms by traditional, indigenous and *terreiro* communities.

In **Public Note n° 6/2021/PFDC/MPF**, PFDC defended the completion of the process of internalizing the Inter-American Convention against Racism, Racial Discrimination and Related Forms of Intolerance, together with the Racial Discrimination Combat and Promotion of Racial Equality WG. The aforementioned convention is considered an important instrument to combat religious intolerance, in view of the treatment of the matter and its definition for legal purposes.

### 3.12 MENTAL HEALTH



#### WORKING GROUP 12 (WG12)

### Guidelines

Until the last decades of the 20th century, being mentally ill in Brazil meant suffering in a cruel and inhuman asylum system. Psychiatric institutions operated as depots for people, in which patients were even tortured by caregivers. The hospitalized people did not receive adequate nutrition, nor did they have minimum hygiene conditions. They also did not receive adequate treatment for their mental illnesses, remaining prisoners for decades, if not dying, in these establishments.

Two cases have become emblematic of the treatment given to the mentally ill in Brazil. One at the Juqueri Psychiatric Hospital, in São Paulo, in which 50,000 patients died between 1960 and 1989, according to the Folha de S. Paulo newspaper. And the Hospital Colônia de Barbacena, in Minas Gerais, where another 60,000 patients died between 1930 and 1980, according to the book Brazilian Holocaust, by reporter Daniela Arbex.

After more than 20 years of struggles, in which mental health staff, patients and their families came together, Law n° 10.216/2001, also known as Pychiatric Reform Law, was approved and changed the treatment of psychiatric patients in the country.

### **3.13 HUMAN RIGHTS** AND BUSINESS



#### WORKING GROUP 13 (WG13)

### Guidelines

Since the first industrial revolution, the introduction of machinery in production has triggered decisive changes in the way of life and work of workers. 16-hour workdays were common in early 19th century in English industries, according to writer Leo Huberman in his History of the Wealth of Man. Spinners spent 14 hours a day – in places where temperatures reached 29 degrees – without being able to get water to drink. In 1816, 7-year-old children worked 15 hours a day, standing, in degrading conditions, for paltry wages. Over the following centuries, labor movements demanded better working conditions, a circumstance that resulted in the recognition of social rights, especially labor rights. In the context of the evolution of human rights, pressure has increased for companies to start to be concerned with environmental and social issues, topics that go beyond the purely economic aspect

Despite this, the landslides of the Fundão dams (Mariana/MG) and the Córrego do Feijão Mine (Brumadinho/MG) are a landmark of how disrespect for human dignity results in catastrophe. Another example of impact is the exploitation of rock salt, in neighborhoods of Maceió (AL), by the petrochemical company Braskem, which caused the subsidence of the soil, destruction of properties and damage to the environment. On the other hand, internet giants such as Facebook are sometimes accused of violating the privacy of their users.

All the examples cited show the offensive potential of companies. In order to avoid such violations, the Human Rights and Business WG works to strengthen public policies aimed at preventing, mitigating and repairing adverse impacts of business on human rights. Among its priorities are the dissemination of knowledge on this topic in the justice system and in the corporate sphere, as well as regulations, including international ones, related to the subject.

WG restructuring

Opening of an administrative procedure in collaboration with *Memory and Truth WG*, to carry out surveys and investigations, in the MP or not, of companies, national or foreign, that were responsible for violations of rights that occurred during the period of the Military Dictatorship. The objective is to identify similar cases to the company Volkswagen do Brasil Indústria de Veículos Automotores Ltda.

CDHM-CD invited PFDC to participate in a meeting with the aim of debating action strategies regarding the social impacts caused by the Ford company's announcement about the end of activities at the factories located in Camaçari (BA) and Taubaté (SP). Representing the agency, a member of the WG highlighted that the issue goes beyond the field of labor rights, affecting various sectors of society. He stated that international human rights principles, as well as those of the International Labor Organization (ILO), are eventually being violated with Ford's decision.

PFDC defended, through Public Note nº 2/2021/PFDC/MPF, the urgency of ratifying an international agreement that guarantees mechanisms for access to information, public participation and protection of environmental activists. He stated that the issue requires commitment from the Executive and Legislative Branches. The note was shared with the Technical Secretariat of the Ibero-american Federation of Ombudsmen (FIO).

The coordinator of the Human Rights and Business WG participated in a public hearing of the CDHM-CD, which dealt with the UN recommendations, within the scope of the UPR, for Brazil to develop a National Action Plan on Business and Human Rights.

# **ACTIONS TAKEN**

2021 0

A coordinated action with the PRDCs of the Federal District and the states of Goiás, Mato Grosso, Rio de Janeiro and São Paulo was carried out to investigate possible acts of violation of fundamental rights and internationally assured human rights, especially the rights to life and health, on the part of the individuals and legal entities that organize, broadcast and sponsor the Copa América of men's football. PFDC held a public hearing to discuss concepts, temporal and territorial frameworks, social participation, asymmetries in the repair process, resettlement and other issues related to people who are victims of the construction, installation, expansion, maintenance or rupture of dams. More than 20 people discussed the issue of the National Policy for People Affected by Dams (PNAB), object of PL n° 2.788/2019. The event is available on the PFDC Youtube Channel.

To mark World Food Day, the webinar **"Violations of Human Rights by Food Sector Companies and the Action of the MP"** took place on October 14th. One of the aspects discussed was hunger as a problem of distribution and not of food production. Although the data indicate that the country has better dealt with the issue of waste, hunger persists and the absence of current data makes it difficult to solve.

The WG coordinator participated in a public hearing at the CDHM-CD on the recommendations of the UN-UPR mechanism, especially to deal with comprehensive reparations in cases of failure of the Mariana and Brumadinho (MG) dams.

From April to July 2021, the WG promoted a cycle of 10 webinars, within the scope of the Citizenship Encounters Project, in which there was a debate on topics such as the process of elaborating the human rights and business treaty; financing by development promotion institutions; centrality of the victim's role; production chain and human rights due diligence; genre; uberization of the economy; human rights violations in the context of large enterprises; and corporate transitional justice.

## PFDC sent Technical Note nº **1/2022/PFDC/MPF** to the Federal Senate on PL N° 2.788/2019, which establishes the National Policy on the Rights of Populations Affected by Dams. The document was produced based on the analysis of contributions made by public authorities, academics, representatives of social movements and civil society collected during a public hearing held in September 2021. For PFDC, the PL meets, to a large extent, Brazilian society's desire for protection regarding losses and damages caused by the construction, operation, deactivation and rupture of dams. One of the merits of the PL is to treat the parties involved equitably and provide legal certainty to the issue. The document was sent to the president of the CD, the Federal Senate, the rapporteur of the project and the president of the Environment Commission.

The third webinar of the cycle of debates on online violence, promoted by PFDC, within the scope of the Citizenship Encounters Project, discussed the responsibility of application providers for the moderation of content that violates human rights. The president of SaferNet Brasil, a member of the Cyber Crimes WG, the 2nd Chamber of Coordination and Review (CCR), and PFDC's Social Security and Population in Street Situation WG participated in the event.

# Guidelines

The supply of medicines by the Unified Health System (SUS) is fixed by Law n° 8.080/1990, also known as the Organic Health Law. It is, therefore, a state obligation that should be fulfilled within certain parameters. The need for medicines and other health supplies leads many citizens to seek their supply from the State using the judicial route. Between 2008 and 2017, there was a 130% increase in lawsuits related to this topic, according to the survey "Judicialization of Health in Brazil: Profile of Demands, Causes and Solution Proposals", carried out by the Institute of Teaching and Research Insper, in partnership with the CNJ.

The activation of the Judiciary for the resolution of demands for medicines had an important milestone with the decision of STF, with general repercussion, regarding to Topic n° 793. According to the Court's understanding, the responsibility for supplying medicines to citizens should be shared between the Union, States and Municipalities. Thus, these spheres of public power, individually or jointly, can be legally sued to provide medication to a person in need.

Based on this reality, Pharmaceutical Assistance and High-Cost Medicine TR works to guarantee and expand the population's access to medicines, especially high-cost medicines, within the SUS, as an essential instrument for an adequate care policy.

TR has also followed the measures adopted by the National Immunization Program (PNI) in relation to the fight against the new coronavirus, together with the PRDCs and the Integrated Covid-19 Epidemic Monitoring Office (GIAC) of the Brazilian MP.

TR restructuring

Meeting with the PFDC and members of the TR, PRDCs and the Integrated Covid-19 Epidemic Monitoring Office (GIAC) to discuss the role of the MPF in monitoring the execution of the National Immunization Plan (PNI). Issues such as guaranteeing access to the vaccine, information systems and strategies to achieve the plan's goals were addressed. PFDC requested information from the Ministry of Health and Anvisa on the measures adopted to prevent the shortage of anticoagulant heparin in health units of Brazil. MPF received representation from the Brazilian Association of Dialysis and Transplant Centers and the Brazilian Society of Nephrology. According to the entity, there was an increase of more than 200% in the prices of commercialization of heparin in the last 12 months and there have been problems in the supply of raw material. Official Letters were reiterated in May 2021.

PFDC sent Technical Note nº 4/2021/PFDC/MPF to the Senate on PL nº 948/2021, which facilitates the purchase and application of vaccines against Covid-19 by legal entities governed by private law. According to the note, current legislation allows the purchase of immunizers, but requires that vaccines be donated to SUS in its entirety. When presenting several criteria that demonstrate the risk of approval of the PL, PFDC considered that the matter had no potential to accelerate the immunization of the population. The agency highlighted that the law device contradicted the Federal Constitution, the basic premises of the SUS, in addition to interfering in the analysis of safety, quality and effectiveness of vaccines, by Anvisa.

The group of regional representatives of patients with Ehlers-Danlos Syndrome (EDS) presented to PFDC a representation requesting the "inclusion of rare diseases in the vaccination program against Covid-19", considering, in particular, the worsening of the "Brazilian health system, in which there was a deficit of ICUs and a risk of lack of essential medicines for humanized and adequate treatment support". As a result, PFDC, following the suggestion of the TR, sent an official letter to the National Health Surveillance Secretariat, the Ministry of Health responsible for the National Vaccination Operational Plan against Covid-19, to clarify the existence of inclusion of people with rare diseases on the plan. The MS responded that it employed pre-approved strategies within the framework of the Tripartite Intermanager Commission (CIT) meetings for the distribution of Covid-19 vaccines. According to the MS, all priority groups were served following vaccination by age group and there was a forecast of vaccination for all those over 18 years of age until the month of September 2021.

# 3.15 HUMAN TRAFFICKING



#### THEMATIC RAPPORTEURSHIP 2 (TR 2)

# Guidelines

Simply put, human trafficking consists of recruiting, moving or harboring people with the aim of exploiting them through some type of coercion, deception or abuse of authority. This exploitation can be of a sexual nature, servitude, slavery or even for the removal of organs.

The description of this crime includes suffering and degrading treatment. Victims are reduced to the condition of objects and even suppliers of spare organs to other people, being stripped of their own humanity. It is almost a consensus that most victims of this crime are targeted because of their socioeconomic vulnerability. Such people are often aware of the risks involved in offers from recruiters, but, for lack of alternatives, they end up accepting them.

When statistics from the Dial 100 service (human rights violations) were used, between 2017 and 2019, there was a preponderance of complaints regarding the sexual exploitation of victims, followed by illegal adoption and exploitation of slave labor.

Due to the whole context presented, the problem of human trafficking deserves increased attention from the public authorities, especially the PFDC, as it is a serious threat to the exercise of human rights. In this sense, the Human Trafficking TR has as a guideline the aim to strengthen public policies to combat human trafficking (Law n° 13.344/2016), in a joint and articulated way with public institutions and civil society entities. This action takes place through guidelines, inter-institutional dialogues and debates on prevention and victim reception mechanisms.

Virtual meetings with the aim of defining strategies for the action plan of the 2020-2022 biennium. The joint work with representatives of other bodies was one of the points discussed. One of the meetings was attended by the Rio de Janeiro Undersecretary for Human Rights and the Labor Prosecutor and National Coordinator for the Eradication of Slave Labor (Conaete). Beginning of discussions for the creation of an Intercameral WG to deal with human trafficking. One of the aspects verified, in the cases of trafficking, is that judges do not look at victims, due to lack of knowledge of the crime itself and because they consider that there was an agreement with the exploitation. Unlike the international standard, which considers the person to be revictimized. The contribution of PFDC is linked to the prevention and reception of the victim, as it has no attribution for judicial prosecution.

Joint Ordinance Nº 1/2021 created and designated the members for the Intercameral WG on international human trafficking associated with corruption. Representatives of the 2nd and 5th CCRs of MPF, the Secretariat for International Cooperation Unit (SCI) and PFDC are part of this working group. The formation of the group took place due to the signing of a joint declaration, prepared within the scope of the Ibero-American Association of Public Prosecutors (AIAMP) in 2020.

Data presented by the 2nd CCR were analyzed by the Intercameral WG on cases related to the crime of human trafficking, from 2017 to 2019.

The Intercameral WG met with Borja Díaz and Ana Linda Solano, from EUROsociAL+, experts on the topic. Among the challenges identified were the integration of priorities, the development of investigations in abbreviated form, the strengthening of information gathering, the carrying out of proactive investigations and the training of the various actors involved. During the event, experts from EUROsociAL+ reported that the Declaration on the World Day against Trafficking in 2020 recognized the role of corruption associated to the crime of human trafficking. The 2020 Consultation on the UN Convention on the Elimination of All Forms of Discrimination against Women (CEDAW) revealed the need to investigate the conduct of public officials in investigations of human trafficking. There are also recommendations from AIAMP and United Against Corruption (UNGASS), in 2021, in the same direction. Other important information presented by the experts included the preparation of a "Guide on corruption and gender", within the scope of the study on "Gender and anti-corruption in Latin America and the Caribbean"; in addition to the development of tools, such as a risk map of corruption and human trafficking.

At the suggestion of the Intercameral WG, the MPF participated in an international campaign on corruption associated with

in an international campaign on corruption associated with human trafficking. The action was promoted, together with EUROsociAL+ by the Network of Prosecutors Against Corruption and the Network of Prosecutors Against Human Trafficking (Redtram), both from AIAMP. <u>A series of reports were produced</u> to raise awareness of the connection between human trafficking and corruption, with the support of the MPF's <u>Secretariat of Social Communication (Secom).</u>

The Intercameral WG prepared Joint Technical Note n° 1/2021 on corruption as a facilitator of international human trafficking. The document suggested the standardization of the work of the federal prosecutors responsible for cases of smuggling of migrants and human trafficking, through joint guidance of the 2nd and 5th CCRs/MPF. The note was intended to help investigators identify corruption associated with these crimes, the practice of which is currently underreported. The rapporteurship's coordinator participated in the CDHM-CD Public Hearing dedicated to the UPR on the theme "Slave labor and human trafficking".

The Intercameral WG promoted a meeting with the consultant Heloísa Greco Alves from the United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime (UNODC), to discuss a study on specialized units in human trafficking in neighboring countries. The consultant conducted interviews and researched the experience of specialized units in three countries: Paraguay, Argentina and Chile. On that occasion, she presented results from the study.

The final version of the study that assesses the feasibility of creating a specialized unit in human trafficking in Brazil was presented. The material meets the request of the MPF to the UNODC and was developed within the scope of the project financed by the Government of Sweden. The document presented international models of specialized structures, as well as concrete recommendations and suggestions for possible organizational models to be adapted and implemented in Brazil.

# **4. INTERNATIONAL PERFORMANCE**



PFDC maintains permanent dialogue with international organizations and institutions, given that Brazil is a signatory to several treaties and conventions on human rights.

In addition to the exchange of experiences, this cooperation promotes the collective construction of work tools with a view to the fulfillment of human rights. Among the partners are the Inter-American Commission and Court of Human Rights (IACHR and Inter-American Court of Human Rights) of the Organization of American States (OAS) and, within the framework of the United Nations (UN), the Office of the United Nations High Commissioner for Human Rights (OHCHR), UN Women, the United Nations Population Fund (UNFPA) and the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees (UNHCR).

The work also involves articulation in regional networks and forums on human rights, such as the Ibero-American Federation of Ombudsmen (FIO), the Human Rights Network of the Community of Portuguese-Speaking Countries (CPLP) and the Latin American Network for the Prevention of Genocide and Massive Atrocities at the Auschwitz Institute.

PFDC has encouraged, through public notices, the adoption of international agreements related to human rights. One of them highlights the importance of Brazil ratifying the Escazú Agreement, which deals with access to information, public participation and access to justice in environmental matters in Latin America and the Caribbean.

In another note, PFDC defended the conclusion of the internalization process of the Inter-American Convention against Racism, Racial Discrimination and Related Forms of Intolerance, which, despite having been ratified in May 2021 by the Parliament, would only reach full legal effectiveness after the presidential decree of promulgation. In January of this year, the Executive finally promulgated the convention (Decree n° 10.932/2022).

#### 4. INTERNATIONAL PERFORMANCE



In January and June 2021, the Federal Ombudsman, Carlos Alberto Vilhena, met with members of the CPLP's Network of Ombudsmen. In the first meeting, there was the approval of a joint declaration of solidarity with Brazil due to the more than 200 thousand deaths resulting from Covid-19. In the following meeting, the authorities participated in the webinar "The organs of the State administration and the duty of cooperation with the ombudsman".

The Substitute Federal Ombudsman, Ana Borges Coêlho Santos, in October 2021, attended the "International Meeting of Defenders of the People - Migration and Refuge", in which the creation of a common front to deal with the humanitarian crisis experienced by migrants in transit across the continent was discussed. The meeting was held in Cartagena, Colombia. In her presentation, Ana Borges spoke of the importance of welcoming migrants and of establishing effective public policies that take care of these vulnerable populations.

In November, Vilhena attended the XXV Meeting of Networks, the General Assembly and the FIO Congress, in Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic. In his speech to the panel Good Governance and Basic Service Access, he defended the construction of a strategic agenda related to educational policies in the context of the Covid-19 pandemic. On the occasion, the participants signed three announcements addressed to public authorities in Latin America and the Caribbean, addressing topics such as the refugee crisis, the increase in gender violence during the pandemic and the situation of the prison population in Ecuador.

In Luanda, capital of Angola, in April 2022, a series of activities took place by the Network of Ombudsmen, National Human Rights Commissions and other National Human Rights Institutions of the CPLP, with the presence of Vilhena. One of the network's objectives is to strengthen the National Human Rights Institutions (NHRI) within the scope of the CPLP member countries. Although Brazil does not have an INDH yet, the Federal Ombudsman, a position established by Complementary Law N° 75/1993, plays the role of national ombudsman, acting, ex officio or through representation, in the defense of constitutional rights.

PFDC has been guided by an increasingly effective communication with its various audiences. For this purpose, it institutionalized the Citizenship Encounters Project, which offers training on the most diverse topics of interest to non-governmental organizations and to society in general. From November 2020 to May 2022, 31 webinars were organized, which had over 16.000 views on YouTube.

It is important to highlight that webinars of the Human Rights and Business cycle gained a new format, through the edition of podcasts. In addition to newsletters, PFDC has invested in the use of Twitter for more immediate communication and in the expansion of a partnership with the MPF Social Communication Department in the use of Instagram and Facebook profiles, which have 95 thousand and 537 thousand followers, respectively. Some numbers that seek to translate the effort made by PFDC in its relationship with society are below.

# **7. ACTUACIONES NAOP Y PRDC**

Created in December 2012, through PGR Ordinance n° 653, the Operational Support Centers for the PFDC (NAOPs) work in each Federal Circuit Prosecutor and aim to decentralize activities, integrating human rights activities within the scope of the MPF. Among the attributions of the Naops, the competence to carry out the review of decisions to decline attribution related to civil inquiries, administrative procedures and informative pieces, in addition to settling attribution conflicts within the scope of the respective region, stand out.

It is also the role of Naops to monitor public policies in the area of human rights, maintain permanent contact and exchange with public and private entities dedicated to the promotion, protection, defense and study in the area of human rights and citizenship. NAOPs are composed by three full members and up to three alternate members, elected by the members of the respective Federal Circuit Prosecutor (PRRs) for a two-year term, with the possibility of reappointment.

PRDCs, present in each of the States, act in the defense of constitutional rights such as freedom, equality, dignity, health, education, social assistance, accessibility, public security, the right to information and free expression, among others. Unlike PFDC, they have both judicial and extrajudicial attribution.

As PFDC, the PRDCs also receive complaints that are forwarded, if applicable, to other competent bodies.

The selection of prosecutors for each PRDC is by appointment of the PGR, the term lasts two years and can be renewed. In 2020, PGR/MPF Ordinance n° 841, of September 30, returned to the PFDC the attribution of reviewing the promotions of filing civil investigations, administrative procedures and informative pieces that are based, in whole or in part, on the execution of TAC, allowing the dissemination of good practices throughout national territory.

In the following pages, you will check the main initiatives developed within the scope of Naops and PRDCs.

From 2019 to 2022, 8,427 procedures were distributed and 9,330 resolved, remaining 418\*.

In this amount there are 252 that refer to Covid-19, an issue considered a matter of high complexity, great impact and repercussion.

There is a specific extrajudicial procedure aimed at implementing, standardizing and monitoring, in the states of Rio de Janeiro and Espírito Santo, the rules and policies that guarantee the supply of water, sewage and electricity during the state of emergency caused by Covid-19, in particular to the population living in slums and neighborhoods with a low presence of public facilities, regardless of the payment situation.

Some NAOPs, such as the 1st and 3rd Region ones, also monitored a coordinated action aimed at increasing the number of children vaccinated with polio in several municipalities, whose vaccine rates were equal to or less than 50%.

A panel with management information, prepared with business intelligence (BI), is available for consultation by the MPF's internal public.

# **7.2 REGIONAL PROSECUTORS FOR CITIZEN'S RIGHTS**

The PRDCs were born with the mission of ensuring effective respect to the rights guaranteed in the Federal Constitution by public authorities and services of public relevance, such as freedom, equality, dignity, health, education, social assistance, accessibility, public security, the right to information and free expression, among others, promoting the necessary measures to guarantee them.

These units act extrajudicially, using so-called administrative measures. Among these are the Public Civil Inquiry (ICP), used to collect information that will support the filing of Public Civil Action (ACP); the Adjustment of Conduct Term (TAC), through which the investigated commits to remedy the irregularity, subject to a fine in case of non-compliance; and the Recommendation, used to alert public bodies about non-compliance with laws. The role of the PRDCs in dealing with the Covid-19 pandemic stands out.

HUMAN RIGHTS	An ACP proposed against the Union requesting that the National Treasury Secretariat refund to the FDD the amount of R\$ 3.2 billion transferred to pay the public debt, in compliance with Law n° 9.008/1995.
EDUCATION AND HUMAN Rights	A Representation of MPF and MP for Accounts of the State of São Paulo, to the TCU against the FNDE and the State of São Paulo, due to the imminent risk of calculation of "fictitious" expenses on the floor in maintenance and development of the teaching of art. 212 of CF/1988 in the financial year of 2021. WOMEN	An ACP filed against the Union seeking reparation and compensation for collective and social moral damages resulting from acts performed by high- ranking federal authorities who, in the exercise and representation of their public functions, violated the constitutionally guaranteed equality between men and women with pronouncements and declarations laden with prejudice and discrimination against women because of their status as females, conduct carried out systematically and materialized, including in administrative actions.
SECURITY AND DATA Protection	An ACP filed against the Federal Government and Microsoft Informática Ltda. requesting that measures are taken to adapt all licenses and/or software of the Windows 10 operating system, so that it no longer collects, as a rule, information and personal data from its users.
