A three-day training for investigation officers from African Ombudsman Organisations will take place in Dar-es-Salaam Tanzania from $2^{nd} - 4^{th}$ January, 2014. The event will be hosted by the Tanzanian IOI member institution (Commission for Human Rights and Good Governance) in cooperation with the IOI and the African Ombudsman Association (AOMA).

The training will be conducted by renowned trainers from the University of Dar-es-Salaam and the Tanzania High Court who have enough knowledge and experience in ombudsman work and administrative justice complaints handling. It will be held in English and consists of a total of nine sessions on Ombudsman's role, the rule of law, accountability, good investigation practice, and use of systemic investigation to bring about transparency in governments.
